What to Bring:

Cell Phones:

We will allow you to bring your cell phones to this event to ensure you can stay connected, check in with your parents/family throughout the week, and use them as an alarm and a camera. We do not want you just sitting around on your phone all day. If you are, we (one of the adult leaders) will ask you to turn in your phone, and you will get it back at the end of the day. This trip is something to experience, and you cannot do it if you are glued to your phone all day—no phones are allowed during service, and only paper Bibles are permitted (See Trent if you need one).
